Phone/TV/Internet - Tips Page

Tip 1: While You're Out of Town

Reroute your phone calls to your cell phone when you're going to be out of town. If you need to be available - for business or otherwise - have your landline phone calls forwarded to your cell phone. Check with your provider, as this service may not be an additional cost to you.

Tip 2: Bundled Discounts

Why pay three separate companies for your telephone, cable, and internet services, when one company may offer a discount for providing two or more services? Ask about bundled packages, so instead of three monthly bills, you'll receive one bill.

Tip 3: Choosing a Cell Phone

Choosing a cell phone can be confusing. There are many features to consider when buying one. So ask yourself questions before you buy. What size do you prefer? How important is sound quality and signal reception? Will you send text messages? What's your budget? Would you consider a family plan where you share minutes?

Tip 4: Cell Phone Plans

When choosing a cell phone plan, it's important to remember a few key factors: the activation charge, the contract term, the consequences of changing your plan, and the service area. You may also want to ask if you can keep your number and if there is a cost to switch your phone number to another company.
